About Saint Stephen's:

Located in beautiful Bradenton, Florida, a town on Florida's gulf coast, Saint Stephen's serves approximately 700 students in PK3 to grade twelve. Founded in 1970, Saint Stephen's is a member of the National Association of Episcopal Schools (NAES), the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) and the Florida Association of Independent Schools (FCIS). Saint Stephen's is "four divisions, one school," fostering connections and community across age groups. The school offers a signature Marine Science Program, with access to the Manatee River from the bayou that runs through the 35 acre campus. The highly-anticipated STEAM center opening next year will support the Arts Conservatory program, and Global Scholars distinction encourages students to connect with their peers from around the world. All of these programs are supported by a faculty that models lifelong learning through their curiosity, dedication, and collaborative spirit.

The Opportunity: Saint Stephen's offers Spanish instruction at every grade level, culminating in the option of Advanced Placement Spanish Language. Global education is one of the school's signature initiatives, and students who dedicate their time to language study, global service, and cross-cultural exchanges earn our Global Scholars Graduation distinction. Saint Stephen's Upper School Spanish courses offer students the opportunity to practice speaking, writing and listening skills in growth-oriented classrooms. Exact courses will vary based on candidate expertise with a particular focus on Underclassmen courses that will make students excited to continue their language education. The teacher should be committed to student success and dedicated to fostering academic curiosity while using student-centered learning techniques.

Generally full-time Upper School faculty members are responsible for the following:

- Teaching five periods of a seven period day, plus study hall coverage;
- Developing and innovating curriculum in collaboration with other department members;
- Creating and updating course pages on the school's Learning Management System;
- Actively engaging with the school community, including club sponsorship and advising a group of students through their four years of Upper School;
- Supervising a break or lunch duty weekly;
- Attending twice-weekly Chapel services with students.
