Stacey Bennett is an Australian pastel portrait and chalk mural artist based in Jimboomba, Queensland. Known for expressive pastel portraiture and large-scale chalk activations, Stacey creates work that brings colour, connection, and storytelling into homes, businesses, and community spaces.

Her practice blends realism with emotional depth, focusing on the humanity and presence of her subjects. Whether crafting intimate pastel portraits or transforming public precincts with immersive chalk murals, Stacey’s work is grounded in connection - between people, place, and story.

Stacey’s public art and chalk installations have been featured at major festivals and events across Queensland and Victoria. Her chalk mural for Swimming Australia’s *Aus vs the World* event was broadcast nationally on Channel 9, and she has collaborated with Logan City Council, Brisbane City Council, Scenic Rim Regional Council, City of Gold Coast, Jimboomba Central, and Assorted Grains Inc.

In 2025, Stacey partnered with artist Lautaro Musse to create Australia’s first 3D Illusion Cube installation at Jimboomba Central - an interactive public artwork that drew significant community engagement. She is a multi-year People’s Choice Award winner at the Yarram Chalk Art Festival (2024, 2026).

Her portraiture has been exhibited across Queensland, including selections in *Petite Pieces* and *Foot Square* at Aspire Gallery, *Embracing Diversity*, and multiple Jimboomba Art Shows, where she has won both the Modern Art Category and People’s Choice Award.

In 2026, Stacey appears on **Portrait Artist of the Year Australia, Season 2**, airing **16 August at 7.30pm on ABC and ABC iview**, marking a major milestone in her evolving portrait practice.

Stacey works across commissioned portraiture, murals, chalk activations, public art, and community-focused creative projects. She welcomes media enquiries, interviews, collaborations, and opportunities to create meaningful, story-driven art throughout South-East Queensland and beyond.
