

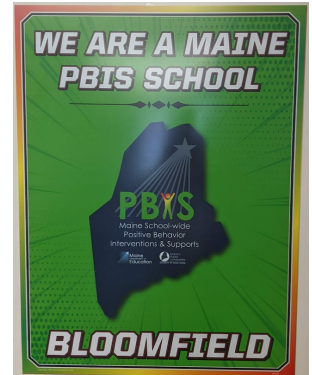
Bloomfield Elementary School PBIS Lesson Plan

Arrival and Dismissal

Expectations: Be Safe, Be Respectful and Kind, Be Responsible

Objective: When arriving at or leaving school, students will be responsible and respectful.

Expectations	Specifics
Be Safe	Ask permission before leaving your group. Keep hands, feet, and things to yourself.
Be Respectful and Kind	Use Voice Level 0-2.
Be Responsible	Keep things in your backpack. Use walking feet.



Teaching Example

Teach- Teacher demonstrates positive behaviors

Be Safe

- Teacher models raising hand to ask permission to use the bathroom.
- Teacher models keeping a backpack and jacket in his/her own space.

Be Respectful and Kind

- Teacher models voice levels 0-2 for students, including the reason for keeping voices down (to hear buses being called).
- Teacher models what a respectful and kind conversation would sound like.

Be Responsible

- Teacher models keeping all personal items in the backpack in order to be prepared for when the bus is called.
- Teacher will model using walking feet, including how to get in line properly (getting right behind the last person in the line).

Model- Teacher and students practice positive behaviors together (have students model).

Practice- Students practice positive behavior without a teacher model.

Scenarios

- 1.) You get in the bus (or walker) line and notice your friend is not in line yet. What do you do?
- 2.) Your friend takes a doll out of his/her backpack and wants you to play with it. What do you do?
- 3.) Someone in your bus line is running. What do you do?
- 4.) You need to return to your classroom because you forgot your boots. What do you do?
- 5.) You want to talk to a friend in another bus line. What do you do?
