## WHAT TO BRING:

- Bedding and pillow for twin bed (sleeping bag or sheets and blanket) Keep in mind that we will be in the mountains and the evenings can be cool.
- Towel, toiletries and shower shoes

  Bathhouses are in a separate building from the cabins/beds so you will be walking to the showers/toilets
- Modest Clothing bring several pairs
  - Bring clothes that can get dirty
  - No tank tops, please
  - Shorts need to be fingertip in length all the way around
  - Jeans/pants may be preferable based on harnesses being required for a lot of the high adventure activities
  - Warmer clothes (sweatshirt, long-sleeved t-shirt) may be desired at night
  - o Pajamas
  - Closed-toed shoes
  - Bathing suit Snowbird has a small pool and large water slide that will be open pending the weather. We will have designated times for the girls and boys to use the pool if open.
     Girls, please wear a modest 1 piece suit or bring a shirt to wear over two-piece suits.
- Bible, notebook, and pen

## **OPTIONAL ITEMS**:

- Snacks
- Refillable water bottle
- Bookbag/cinch bag to carry personal items
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Extra money for Snack Shack (food, souvenirs, shirts), additional paintballs and skeet
- Sunscreen
