### **WORLD STUDIES EXPECTATIONS**

## **HOW TO SUCCEED IN THIS CLASS**

- All grades are posted with weekly updates. Do not wait until the last day of the quarter to come to me and ask for makeup work.
- Speaking of make up work, you can pass in homework late and receive half credit.
- HOMEWORK COUNTS and it CAN HELP YOU if you do it.
- Come to class on time. Any time after the bell is late. Please do not tell me: "I was just a second late". That is still late.
- Come to class prepared everyday. That means **your three ring binder**, a writing utensil and your book when told to bring it.
- Participation in class works for you. You must add positive information to this class.
- Ask questions. The only bad question is the question not asked.
- Raise your hand if you want to speak to the class to add to the discussion; otherwise, please don't socialize because the background noise can be distracting to others who need quiet to learn.
- Respect the people in the class. I will not tolerate put downs even if you are friends. I will not tolerate swears.
- If you work in this class it is easy to achieve a good grade. It takes more work in my opinion to flunk than pass. Have an open mind about assignments. If every assignment is "queer" or "stupid" then you won't put the effort into the assignment.
- I treat you with respect. I expect the same in return. Acting boorish in class (as explained) is not respect.
- Detentions will be writing a reflective essay, working on homework or cleaning the room.

### **GRADING**

Tests and quizzes count for **75%** of your quarter grade.

- Quizzes count once and tests count twice and projects vary.
- Homework counts for **25%** of your quarter grade. You will receive a 0-10 for a grade. You will receive points based on the amount of work done and effort. If it is not done it is a 0. If it is done above and beyond what is needed you can get up to a 15 (extra credit). If it is late (one day is the same as 4 weeks) you will get half credit a 5.

\*I post updated grades to ASPEN every few days. Please do not tell me: "I didn't know what my grade was or I would have tried harder". You will know your grade to the decimal point. Don't use the excuse that "You do not do well because Mr. Perlow doesn't like me". That has nothing to do with your grading. I hand back all work and you will keep it in your 3 ring binder this will prevent grading mistakes. You can always ask about the grade you receive, but realize I will not discuss it in the middle of the class.
