SCHOLARSHIP NEWS 2024-2025

As you are preparing for college, continue to be diligent in your quest to earn funds!

1. Seniors, you may start working on your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) beginning December 1, 2024. Although some families may not qualify for federal or state aid, it is a free form. It can help make you eligible for grants and the federal work study program on your college campus. The work study program ensures that you will have a job where you attend college. Money earned can be directly sent to the school's financial aid office to be used toward tuition. Note: Some of you may not be eligible to earn some college scholarships and grant money, unless you complete the 2025-2026 FAFSA. Go to https://studentaid.gov/ to create your FSA ID (username/password) and for more information.

2. Another way to earn money is through merit awards. These are scholarships most colleges offer and students are automatically eligible for, as long as they apply before the college's deadline. Typically, they are based on a combination of grade point average and SAT/ACT test scores. Colleges notify students directly if they are eligible for these types of financial awards. Keep in mind that applying to an honors college can also increase your eligibility for more money too.

3. Once you have been accepted at a college/university, you may also be eligible for departmental awards or private scholarships from the academic institution. They have separate applications and likely different deadlines. For example, Grand Valley is well known for having many scholarship offerings for their incoming students at https://gvsu.academicworks.com/opportunities/.

4. Scholarship databases are another great way to search for scholarships. Websites like https://scholarshipamerica.org/ or bigfuture.collegeboard.org ask you to complete a personal questionnaire. Once completed, you will be given a list of scholarships for which you qualify to apply. There are too many scholarship databases to count, so our advice is to choose one (see the chart below) and cross reference your results with a second database. Some results may be the same.

5. SHS has a list of scholarships available solely for our students (see below). This list changes periodically throughout the year. Keep checking it! As a reminder, when you earn a scholarship, ALWAYS write a sincere thank you note to the scholarship donor.
