

CSU Instructions:

1. Log in to LibGuides and select Create Guide
2. Under Choose Layout or Reuse, select Copy content/layout from an existing guide
3. Click the “Community Guides” radio button
4. Copy and paste this URL into the search box:
https://library.ctstate.edu/Manchester/Template_AAPI_Heritage_Month
5. Name your guide, fill out the rest of the information as necessary, and click Create Guide
6. Edit your library name where indicated
7. Navigate to the first page you want to add books to - i.e. [Your Library] Books
 - a. Add a hidden (draft mode) box to the bottom of the page
 - b. In that box, start adding “Books from the Catalog”
 - i. Search the book you want to appear in the gallery, copy and paste the ISBN and click Load Book Info
 - ii. The cover art, title, and description should appear
 - c. Once you have added all the books you want to include in a particular section, navigate to the box for that section (i.e. History) and click on the gear icon in the upper right hand corner
 - i. Click Add New Slide and select Book
 - ii. Start typing the title of one of the books you added in the hidden box
 - iii. Click Add, then select the edit icon
 - iv. Search the book in your catalog (or the consortium), copy the Permalink, and paste it into the Link URL box
8. Repeat the process for the other categories!

Instructions for CT State Libraries:

1. Log in to LibGuides and select Create Guide
2. Under Choose Layout or Reuse, select “Copy content/layout from an existing guide”
3. Select the “Local Guides” radio button
4. Search for and select the “Template for Women’s History Month Mini Collection”
5. Check the “Copy Assets” box
6. Under Guide Name, include your campus name, (e.g., Manchester Women’s History Month Mini Collection)
7. Adjust the guide type as needed
8. Under Group Assignment, select your campus group (e.g. Manchester guides)
9. Before you can add books to the gallery boxes, you will first need to make sure the titles are in your assets library. To check & add titles to your assets library
 - a. Choose Assets from the Content dropdown menu

- b. Search for each book you would like to add to the various gallery boxes
 - i. Filter by owner to limit the results to your library's assets library
- c. If the title is not in your assets library, click Add Content Item
 - i. Select "Book from the Catalog"
 - ii. Search your library's catalog for the title
 - iii. Copy and paste the ISBN from the catalog record and click Get Book Info
 - iv. The cover art, title, & description should populate automatically
 1. For books in your library's holdings, add your campus name to the end of the book title – e.g., *How to be an antiracist* (Manchester).
 2. This will make it easier to find the book that is linked to your library's catalog record when adding content to the galleries
 - v. Copy and paste the permalink from the catalog record into the URL box
 - vi. Click Save
- d. To add books to the gallery boxes
 - i. Select the gear icon
 - ii. Click Add New Slide and select Book
 - iii. Start typing the title of one of the books you added to your assets
 - iv. Select the correct title and click Add
 - v. Save and Return to Guide when you are done
 - vi. Repeat the process for the other gallery boxes!

Note: The gallery settings have already been set up for you and are ready to use!
