INTRODUCTION [Times New Roman 12 bold]

The introduction includes the background to a problem as well as the urgency and rationalization of activities (research or service). Activity objectives and problem solving plans are presented in this section. A review of relevant literature and hypothesis development are included in this section. Avoid sub-subs in the introduction [Times New Roman, 12, normal] page percentage between 10-15% of total words, 1 spaced.

RESEARCH METHODS [Times New Roman 12 bold]

Research methods explain the approach, activity design, scope or object, main materials and tools, place, data collection techniques, operational definitions of research variables, and analysis techniques.

Avoid writing excessive statistical formulas and sub-subs in research methods [Times New Roman, 12, normal], single space.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION [Times New Roman 12 bold]

This section presents the research results. Research results can be accompanied by tables, graphs (images), and/or charts. The discussion section explains the results of data processing, interprets findings logically, links them to relevant reference sources. [Times New Roman, 12, normal], 1 space. PNG/jpg image format. Avoid sub-subs in Results and discussion.

CONCLUSION [Times New Roman 12 bold]

The conclusion contains a summary of the research results and discussion. [Times New Roman, 12, normal], single space.

Contains thanks to the funding institutions/individuals, and/or those who have assisted in carrying out the research and writing the manuscript as well as the author's affiliated institutions. [Times New Roman, 12, normal], single space.
