 - e.g. Google Meet
- » Phone calls
- » Small group lessons
 - by proficiency level
 - with scaffolds
 - in mixed groups
 - fluency building
- » Teacher feedback & support as needed

Asynchronous ELD options

- » Previously-recorded lessons & videos
- » Phone & text messages
- » Choice Board activities & other independent ELD assignments or projects
 - e.g., Google Classroom/Canvas
- » Paper/pencil activities
- » Reading logs & journals
- » Goal setting & reflection
