Your summer reading project serves as the first stepping stone on your journey. As you read Adeyemi's story of magic and monarchy, it will become clear just how important and powerful one voice can be in the face of extreme adversity--and how different those voices can sound to the self and to others.

The Assignment

Make a copy of the graphic organizer to create your own.

Step 1: Read

The first step in your summer reading assignment is to simply read *Children of Blood and Bone*! **Enjoy your summer and your summer reading!**

Step 2: <u>Graphic Organizer</u>

One of the major topics/motivations for Adeyemi was to **share a different perspective to what was going on in her life and community** surrounding police brutality and the Black Lives Matter Movement. She wanted to make sure that the perspectives of the group she belongs to were being shared, even in fictional/fantasy spaces. **We want you to see how each character's sense of individual identity is shaped by ideals crafted by others in order to oppress or empower.**

The best things you can do are: 1) read the book 2) try your best on the graphic organizer
