 - **Once downloaded, adjust the settings to your preference**
 - Receive real-time push notifications with updates about grades, scores, attendance, assignments, teacher comments, daily bulletins, schedules, and fee transactions
 - Access all of your children in one portal
 - View grades, assignments, attendance, GPA, and more

For best results, view daily as phone notifications settings may interfere with the app notifications.
