UI-Con Prop & Costume Policy 2025

Introduction

Hello UI-Con Attendees! Below are our policies and guidelines that you must follow. These are specific to UI-Con, so please read them carefully.

All props are required to be checked in at the Prop Check-In in the registration/badge pick-up room. Any props seen in convention rooms without the colored tie attached to them will be asked to be checked in or confiscated.

UI-Con will be following the University's policy on weapons: <u>Student Discipline -</u> <u>Possession or Storage of Weapons</u>

Additional policies:

- Shoes must be worn even if the character you are cosplaying does not.
- Body paint must be dry and sealed any damage done to the venue itself or the furniture will result in damage expenses.
- Full face coverings are allowed (as in masks, helmets, fursuits, etc), but must be removed during check in and if prompted by security or convention staff.
- Costumes and Props may not display any vulgar language or images.
- Metal props with points or blades are not allowed, even if they are blunt. If you choose to bring a sheathed sword with a metal blade, the casing will be closed with zip ties. If the prop is opened under any circumstances, it will be confiscated by convention staff.
- Real firearms are not allowed.
- Life-like gun props are not allowed. This includes airsoft guns or anything painted to look like a real gun. <u>This includes fake guns with orange painted tips.</u>
- Real bows or crossbows are not allowed. If your prop is made to resemble these weapons, it may not have any ammunition or be firable in any way.

Please remember that if your costume or prop causes mobility issues, you must have a handler for support.
