

Kenosha Unified Athletics – Hall of Fame Inductee – Class of 1984

Gene Englund – 1936

Gene Englund's sports history at Kenosha High School is replete with good Kenosha names...Roy Liddicoat was his coach at Lincoln Jr. High, Fred Bauer his coach at high school, where Geroge N. Tremper was the beloved principal. Gene earned 4 letters at high school, both in basketball and tennis, participating in the Big 8 conference and establishing a scoring record.

Four years at the University of Wisconsin added to Gene's honors where he was All American Center on the national championship team, won a Chicago Tribune trophy, was captain and MVP in his senior year. Professionally, Gene played with the Oshkosh All Stars, continuing through 1949, with time out for service in the Navy. He played with the Celtics, retired from active play, and became an official for the NBA, and a Big 10 official for 5 more years.
