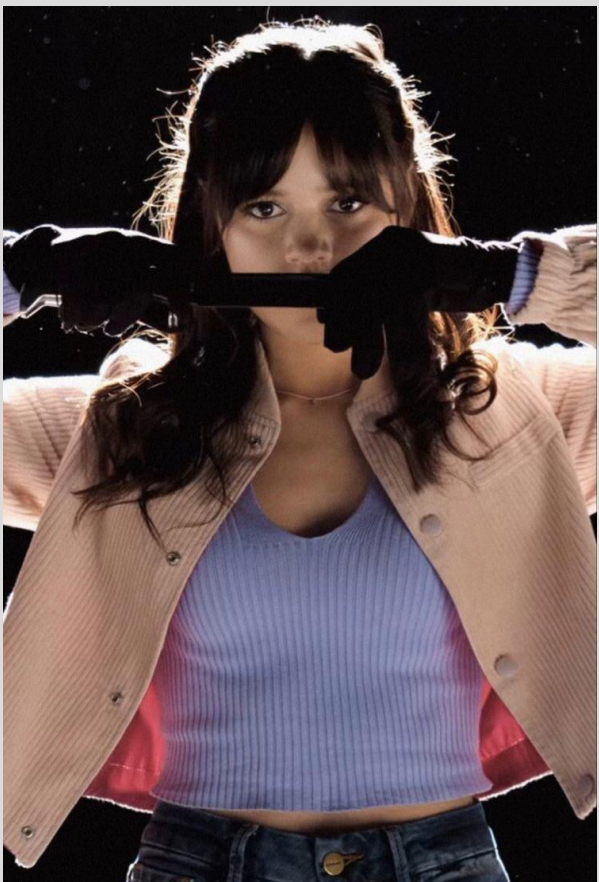


Some Help at Featherweight
