# Off-Campus Lunch Pass Policy

*PLEASE READ CAREFULLY*

The governing board of the Bonita Unified School District, pursuant to section 44808.5 of the Education Code, has decided to permit qualified pupils enrolled at Bonita High School to leave the school grounds during the lunch period. **The Off Campus Lunch Pass is considered a privilege and can be revoked at any time due to academic, attendance, or behavioral issues.** Section 44808.5 of the Education Code further states: "Neither the school district, nor any of its officers or employees thereof shall be liable for the conduct nor safety of any pupil during such time as the pupil has left the school grounds pursuant to this section."

### Off Campus Lunch Policy

1. Only eligible juniors and seniors will be issued an off-campus sticker only upon the receipt of a completed and signed authorization form.
2. Eligibility requirements are: 2.0 or better gpa the previous grading period, 90% or higher attendance rate the previous grading period, and no outstanding disciplinary assignments.
3. **Students are expected to show their Minga ID card with the off-campus lunch sticker when leaving campus.** If the student has forgotten their lunch pass, they may request an emergency pass from the Assistant Principal's office (one per semester only).
4. If a student does not return to school at all, the student (if 18 years of age) or the parent must call the school that **same day, prior to 4:00 PM**. Failure to do so will result in a truancy and a potential Saturday School.
5. Students may lose their "Off Campus" privilege for the following reasons:
  - Disrespect to school staff.
  - Misrepresenting the ID in any way.
  - Transporting unauthorized students.
  - Visiting other schools or interfering in any way with community activities.
  - Failing to return punctually and regularly from lunch to 6th period class.
  - Poor attendance (i.e. Below 90%)
  - Failure to serve Saturday school
  - Issuance of a Suspension
  - Excessive Tardies
6. **Requirements will be re-evaluated every quarter.** Students that do not meet the academic, attendance and behavioral requirements may have their privilege revoked at any time.
