CBS News Los Angeles has partnered with the <u>American Red Cross</u> to support the communities in need. The organization said <u>it is staffing</u> <u>evacuation centers</u> and providing supplies.

<u>World Central Kitchen</u>, founded by <u>chef José Andrés</u>, said it has <u>mobilized across Southern California</u>, providing sandwiches and water throughout the region. The charity said its volunteer chefs are on standby to give out meals.

The <u>Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation</u> has called for donations to its wildfire emergency fund. The proceeds will go toward equipping firefighters with tools and supplies to contain the inferno.

The <u>Los Angeles Regional Food Bank</u> is accepting food donations and volunteers.

The <u>California Fire Foundation</u> said it is working with local fire departments and community organizations to support impacted residents financially. The group's wildfire and disaster relief fund directly supports victims of blazes and other disasters throughout the state, <u>according to its website</u>.

The <u>League of California Community Foundations</u>, a coalition of the state's nonprofits, is coordinating relief efforts for people affected by the <u>Palisades</u> and <u>Eaton</u> fires. The California Community Foundation said funds raised after previous disasters have helped rebuild homes, restore lost belongings and provide support services such as mental health management.

The <u>Anderson Munger Family YMCA</u> in Los Angeles is seeking donations of food, snacks, water and essential and emergency supplies. The Y said on Instagram it is accepting deliveries at its Koreatown location.

The Los Angeles-based <u>International Medical Corps</u> has been coordinating with local health groups to deliver relief supplies, including hygiene and first-aid kits, to communities affected by the fires. The group said it also is ready to provide additional support and services to health facilities if needed.

2024 RESOURCES: REPUBLICAN HOUSE TARGETS

Republicans Representing Districts Biden Won in 2020

Republicans currently have a very slim majority in the House of Representatives. Flipping the vulnerable seats of the Representatives listed below in 2024 can take control of Congress out of the hands of the radical right wing. They were originally called the "Biden 18."

ARIZONA

--District 1 - Rep. David Schweikert (R)

<u>Located in northeastern Maricopa County, Arizona's District 1 includes Scottsdale, Paradise Valley, and Chandler; is majority-white; and is the wealthiest congressional district in Arizona.</u>

--District 6 - Rep. Juan Ciscomani (R)

Arizona's District 6 encompasses all of Greenlee County, most of Cochise County, and parts of Pima County, Pinal County, and Graham County. Most of its population resides in suburbs of Tucson, including Oro Valley, Marana, Green Valley, and Vail.

CALIFORNIA

--District 13 - Rep. John Duarte ® -

Unseating Duarte is one of the prime goals for All Rise Alameda in 2024!

In the 2022 redistricting cycle, the district was moved to the San Joaquin Valley. The old 13th district was renumbered as the 12th (and is now represented by Barbara Lee). The new (current) 13th district includes all of Merced County; most of the population of Madera County; and parts of Stanislaus, Fresno, and San Joaquin Counties. It includes the cities of Merced, Madera, Ceres, Patterson, Lathrop, Chowchilla, Atwater, Coalinga, and Mendota; as well as the southern parts of both Modesto and Turlock.

--District 22 - Rep. David Valadao ®

<u>Unseating Valadao is also high on the goal list for All Rise Alameda in 2024!</u>

Following redistricting in 2021, California's District 22 in the San Joaquin Valley includes most of Kings County and parts of Tulare and Kern Counties. It includes the east side of Bakersfield; the west and south sides of Tulare, the south side of Hanford; and all of Porterville, Lindsay, Shafter, Wasco, Delano, McFarland, Arvin, Lamont, and Corcoran. It is now a majority-Latino district.

--District 27 - Rep. Mike Garcia (R)

California's District 27 includes most of northern Los Angeles County, including the cities of Santa Clarita, Palmdale, and Lancaster, and parts of the northwestern San Fernando Valley in the city of Los Angeles. Prior to redistricting in 2022, the district was located in the San Gabriel Valley.

--District 40 - Rep. Young Kim (R)

California's 40th congressional district encompasses Orange, San Bernardino, and Riverside counties. The district includes Yorba Linda, Anaheim Hills, Orange, Chino Hills, Tustin, Mission Viejo, Aliso Viejo, Rancho Santa Margarita, Laguna Hills, Laguna Woods, Villa Park, Lake Forest, the unincorporated communities of North Tustin and Coto de Caza, and part of Brea and Corona.

--District 45 - Rep. Michelle Steel (R)

<u>California's 45th Congressional District includes the cities of Fountain Valley, Westminster, Garden Grove, Cypress, Buena Park, Cerritos, Artesia, La Palma, Placentia, Hawaiian</u>
Gardens, Los Alamitos, Rossmoor, and parts of Brea, Lakewood, Fullerton, and Yorba Linda.

NEBRASKA

--District 2 - Rep. Don Bacon (R)

<u>Nebraska's District 2 encompasses the core of the Omaha metropolitan area which includes all of Douglas County and the suburban areas of western Sarpy County.</u>

NEW JERSEY

--District 7 - Rep. Tom Kean, Jr. (R)

New Jersey Towns in District 7: Berkeley Heights, Clark, Fanwood, Linden (part; also 10th), Mountainside, New Providence, Rahway, Scotch Plains, Springfield, Summit, Westfield and Winfield Township.

NEW YORK

--District 1 - Rep. Nick LaLota

New York's District 1 in eastern Long Island includes the eastern two-thirds of Suffolk County, including the northern portion of Brookhaven, as well as the entirety of the towns of Huntington, Smithtown, Riverhead, Southold, Southampton, East Hampton, and Shelter Island. The district encompasses extremely wealthy enclaves such as the Hamptons, middle class suburban town such as Selden, Centereach, and Lake Grove, working-class towns such as Riverhead and rural farming communities such as Mattituck and Jamesport on the North Fork.

--District 3 – Rep. George Santos ® RESIGNED - Now replaced by Dem. Tom Suozzi!

NY-03 is the wealthiest congressional district in New York. It includes part of the North Shore of Long Island and expands across northern Nassau County and into far northeastern

Queens. Long Island communities in the district include Oyster Bay Cove, Old Brookville, Levittown, Glen Cove, Roslyn, Manhasset, Plainview, Bethpage, Port Washington, Hicksville, Jericho, Syosset, Mineola, Farmingdale, Massapequa Park, and Great Neck. Queens neighborhoods in the district include Little Neck, Whitestone, Glen Oaks, Floral Park, and Queens Village.

--District 4 - Rep. Anthony D'Esposito (R)

NY-04 is the second-wealthiest congressional district and is located in central and southern Nassauy County. The district includes the communities of Elmont, Baldwin, Bellmore, East Rockaway, East Meadow, Five Towns, Lynbrook, Floral Park, Franklin Square, Garden City, Garden City Park, Hempstead, Atlantic Beach, Long Beach, Malverne, Freeport, Merrick, Carle Place, New Hyde Park, Oceanside, Rockville Centre, Roosevelt, Seaford, Uniondale, Wantagh, West Hempstead, Westbury, and Valley Stream.

--District 17 – Rep. Mike Lawler (R)

<u>New York's District 17 includes all of Rockland County and Putnam County, as well as most of Northern Westchester County, and portions of southern Dutchess County.</u>

--District 19 - Rep. Marc Molinaro (R)

New York's 19th congressional district is located in New York's Catskills, Hudson Valley, Southern Tier, and Finger Lakes regions. It lies partially in the northernmost region of the New York metropolitan area and south of Albany.

--District 22 - Rep. Brandon Williams (R)

<u>Significant cities in New York's District 22 include Syracuse, Utica, and Rome. It is home to several colleges and universities, including Syracuse University, Hamilton College, Colgate University, SUNY Polytechnic Institute and Utica College.</u>

OREGON

--District 5 - Rep. Lori Chavez-Dereme (R)

Oregon's 5th congressional district stretches from the Southeast suburbs of Portland through the eastern half of the Willamette Valley and then reaches across the Cascades to take in Sisters and Bend. It includes a sliver of Multnomah County, the majority of Clackamas County, the rural eastern portion of Marion County, all of Linn County, a very small section of southwest Jefferson County, and the populated northwest portion of Deschutes County. It was significantly redrawn when Oregon gained a 6th congressional district after the 2020 Census.

PENNSYLVANIA

--District 1 - Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick (R)

<u>Pennsylvania's first congressional district includes all of Bucks County and a sliver of Montgomery County in southeastern Pennsylvania.</u>

VIRGINIA

--District 2 - Rep. Jen Kiggans

Virginia's District 2 currently encompasses all of Accomack, Northampton, and Isle of Wight; all of the independent cities of Virginia Beach, Suffolk, and Franklin; part of the independent city of Chesapeake; and part of Southampton. The district has a significant military presence. The Hampton Roads area is considered to be a military town.
