Engaging Scenario

As we ponder on the different basic and complex information of the Church, we have discovered that the Catholic Church evolved throughout the years with the works of the Holy Spirit. Like what is said in Lumen Gentium *“The term ‘laity’ is here understood to mean all the faithful except those in Holy Orders and those who belong to a religious state approved by the Church. That is, the faithful who by Baptism are incorporated into Christ and integrated into the People of God, are made sharers in their particular way in the priestly, prophetic and kingly office of Christ, and have their own part to play in the mission of the whole Christian people in the Church and in the world.” (LG 31)*

Lay people in this sense include everyone in the Church who are not consecrated. With this idea, we can boldly say that as lay members of the Church, everyone must participate in the three-fold mission of the Church; Priestly, Kingly and Prophetic. Hence, lay people are the partners of the consecrated people to ensure that the Church is doing her role and responsibility to make all her members holy and be one with the mission of sharing the life and teaching of Christ; EVANGELIZATION. As lay people, we called to be a co-leader and worker of the Church through active participation in different activities and organization, frequent attendance to the celebration of Holy Eucharist and other sacraments. Even a simple act like praying for the Church is serious and has a big importance to the vital role of the lay people as members of the Church.
