

## POLICY JLDBH SUICIDE PREVENTION

It is the intent of Windsor Charter Academy employees and officials to provide a learning environment that fosters the development of all students. In the event of a suicide threat or a completed suicide, the school will take reasonable steps to identify, evaluate, and intervene on behalf of students who are at risk.

When a student threatens suicide or manifests the signs of his/her intent, immediate action will be taken to intervene on behalf of the student. The school will not provide in-depth counseling but will make appropriate referrals in consultation with the Weld Re-4 District/contracted mental health staff. The school will not make any decisions related to emergency placement. This decision is the responsibility of the parent and/or law enforcement agencies.

Any school employee who knows of a suicide threat must report this information to a designated Windsor Charter Academy Crisis Response Team member. A member of this team will notify the parents, appropriate public officials, and/or agencies as the situation warrants.

## Windsor Charter Academy Crisis Response Team

The Windsor Charter Academy Crisis Response Team will operate in accordance with Windsor Charter Academy's developed administrative guidelines, which may be amended from time to time.
