3. Who is the first person he asks for help? What is her reply?
4. Who is the second person he asks for help? Why can't that person help him?
5. Who is the third person he asks for help? How does he try to help Juppiter?
6. Who is the last person he asks for help? Why does this person **initially** think he can't help Juppiter?
7. What tool does Vulcanus use? What is his goal?
8. What shocking thing happens after Vulcanus uses that tool?
9. Why is Vulcanus happy at the end of the chapter? Based on prior knowledge of Vulcanus, which of our main characters (Prometheus or Epimetheus) do you think he better aligns with? Why?
