Reminders for Weekly Curbside Collection

- Trash/recycling is collected one (1) day per week on **Fridays**.
- Trash and recycling must be secured in containers – not in loose bags or boxes.
- Trash and recycle containers are to be placed out for pickup **no earlier** than 7 pm on the night before scheduled collection and are to be removed from common ground by 7 pm the day following pickup.
- Trash cans may be stored in front of a unit provided they are kept in Anne Arundel County approved covered plastic containers and obscured from view of the streets by shrubbery or a structure approved by the Association or Architectural Committee.

General Guidelines from Anne Arundel County Waste Management for Weekly Curbside Collections:

- The loaded containers cannot weigh more than 40 pounds each so they can be lifted safely.
- Mark all yard waste containers and non-County issued recycling containers with an “X” so the collectors know it’s recycling, not trash. County issued yellow containers need not be marked with “X’s”. Do not place yard waste in a County issued yellow container.
- Containers may be placed at the curb between 7 pm the night before your collection day and 6 am on your collection day.
- Your material will be collected on your regularly scheduled collection day unless that day falls on New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day. In the event your collection day falls on one of these six holidays or we experience inclement weather, your collection will be delayed.
