Each contributing author will extract the following details: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Author name.</b> We will reproduce it exactly, so any middle names and/or initials they want featured must be included.</li> <li>• <b>Author affiliation.</b> This should be where they were based when the research for the paper was conducted.</li> <li>• <b>Author email address.</b> A clear indication and an active email address of all authors. Particularly for the corresponding author, we advise to use an active university or institution email address.</li> <li>• <b>Author ORCID.</b> Identification number of researchers or academics</li> </ul>	
<b>2. Abstract</b> Abstract must adhere to the following: A concise and factual abstract is required. <b>Please provide an abstract of at least 150 words and a maximum of 250 words.</b> The abstract should describe the following items in order of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Purpose</b> (for example. The study investigates/examines..., but no research background statements/problem statements at the beginning),</li> <li>• <b>Methodology</b> (for example. This study employs samples/survey data/time series data of ....),</li> <li>• <b>Finding</b> (for example, The findings of this study suggest that ...),</li> <li>• <b>Implications</b> (for example. This research is useful for improving ....)</li> <li>• <b>Originality</b> (for example. This study contribute to...).</li> </ul>	

<b>3. Keywords:</b> Please provide maximum of 5 keywords, separated by comma (,). It is crucial to the appropriate indexing of the papers are to be given. e.g., Islamic Bank, Halal Product, Model Dynamics.	
<b>4. JEL Classification Code:</b> Please provide 3-5 JEL classification codes, separated by comma (,) These codes will be used for indexing purposes.

Be sparing in the use of tables and ensure that the data presented in tables do not duplicate results described elsewhere in the article.</li> <li>• A paper in RISFE from now on may include a maximum of six (6) tables/figures/appendixes in total.</li> <li>• In particular, RISFE does not accept any figures/artworks borrowed from others (i.e. output of AMOS, charts and reports of Statistics Agency's), if not created by the author's own work.</li> </ul>
