



Trauma-Throw Bags (TTBs) Instructions & Information

- 1) Each TTB contains the following bleeding control supplies:
 - (30) C.A.T. Tourniquets
 - (30) 4-yard rolled gauze bandages.You may add additional items but cannot remove the original contents in the TTBs.
- 2) The TTBs are to be stored in your agency's supervisor vehicles only within **Los Angeles County**.
- 3) The TTBs are not intended for regular daily operational use. They are intended to be used during a mass-casualty patient surge incident (*e.g., Route 91 Vegas mass shooting, Boston marathon bombing incident, etc.*).
- 4) The contents of the TTBs are locked via a break-away tag with a unique serial number. If the tag is broken and/or any of the contents have been used, report it to Nnabuike Nwanonyi nwanon@dhs.lacounty.gov or 562-378-2460
- 5) The numbered break-away tags sealed to the TTBs are assigned to your specific agency. **DO NOT** exchange the TTBs with other providers.
- 6) The TTBs are LA County assets purchased with federal funds and will be tracked on an annual basis.
