

SY 2023-24 West Bloomfield Middle School Athletic Guidelines

Any athlete participating in a middle school sport must adhere to the following academic, registration and behavior requirements:

Academic:

- Students will **not** be eligible if they are **failing two or more courses**
- *Students will **not** be eligible if they have a combination of **4 Ds and Fs out of 6 classes** (advisory is not included as it is not graded).

Behavior:

- **Any school suspension** may result in dismissal from the team unless special consideration is given by the building principal or athletic administrator.
- Any other disciplinary issues (lunch or after school detentions, stemming from Code of Conduct violations including, but not limited to insubordination, inappropriate verbal or physical behavior, excessive tardies, not following staff directions, cell phone use) will be reviewed and assessed based on severity, frequency and recurrences. Consequences may vary from missed practices/games to removal from the current team.
- Students must be picked up from practices and games on time. **If a parent is more than 15 minutes late, 2 times during one season, the student will be removed from the team.** This includes games that are AWAY. The district only provides transportation TO the away events and not home (football is the only exception).
- Uniforms are given out to athletes who are officially part of the team. Uniforms must be turned in at the end of the season in order for the athlete to participate in another sport.
- Students who leave campus before, during or after a practice or a game without the knowledge of the coach will be removed from the team.
- Students must attend practices and games. Students with 3 unexcused absences will be removed from the team. Absences are excused through the coach and this data will be recorded on Final Forms. Students who refuse to participate for three days will be removed from the team.

Registration:

- In order to be part of the team all forms on Final Forms must be completed including but not limited to:

Physical form

Permission to treat forms

Signatures by parent and student

- We must have a physical on file dated on or after April 15, 2023 and a permission to treat form and the Final Forms on-line registration form needs to be completed (links found at the WBHS athletics website).
