1. Introduction

The Centre for GOOD Travel ("we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website good-travel.org, book our trips, take part in our programmes, or use any of our services.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect information about you in a variety of ways. The information we may collect includes:

- **Payment Information:** Payment details, including credit card information, billing address, and other related information.

- **Automatically Collected Data:** Information automatically collected when you access our website, such as IP address, browser type, access times, and the pages you have viewed directly before and after accessing the website.

3. Use of Your Information

We may use the information we collect from you in the following ways:

- To process your transactions and manage your bookings.
- To personalize your experience and respond better to your individual needs.
- To improve our website and services.
- To send periodic emails regarding your order or other products and services.
- To follow up with you after correspondence (live chat, email, or phone inquiries).

4. Disclosure of Your Information

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your Personally Identifiable Information unless we provide users with advance notice. This does not include website hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or serving our users, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release information when its release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others' rights, property or safety.

5. Security of Your Information

We use administrative, technical, and physical security measures to help protect your personal information. While we have taken reasonable steps to secure the personal information you provide to us, please be aware that despite our efforts, no security measures are perfect or impenetrable, and no method of data transmission can be guaranteed against any interception or other type of misuse.

6. Cookies and Tracking Technologies
