

Biography for Guy Jorstad

Mr. Jorstad graduated from Grove City College with a Bachelor of Arts in Literature, Communication and Secondary Education in 1991. After graduation he married and promptly moved to Louisa County Virginia where he was a 7th Grade Language Arts teacher.
