

Result

Sub-theme 1

Write results in a logical sequence. Results with important findings should be present first. When presenting results in a table or figure, do not repeat all those contents in the text. The produced data are presented in tables, or figures with an explanation of what is the result/findings from the work. Results should be able to answer the hypothesis.

Sub-theme 2

The relationship between the tables or figures and the text should be clear. As the tables and figures supplement the text, they should all be referenced in the text. Authors must also explain what the readers should look for when using the tables or figures. All tables and figures must be referenced using APA 7th edition standard.

**Tables.** Title of a table, must be put above the table. In writing the title of a table, you must capitalize each word. All tables and figures must be consecutively numbered. Figures must be made center-align and left-align for tables.

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Tables should be typed and included in the main body of the article. The position of tables should be inserted in the text as close to the point of reference as possible. Ensure that any superscripts or asterisks are shown next to the relevant items and have corresponding explanations displayed as footnotes to the table, figure or plate.

### Sub-theme 3

**Figures.** Figures (charts, diagrams, line drawings, web pages/screenshots, and photographic images) should be submitted in electronic form. All Figures should be of high quality, legible and numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals. Graphics may be supplied in colour to facilitate their appearance on the online database. Figures created in MS Word, MS PowerPoint, MS Excel should be supplied in their native formats. Electronic figures created in other applications should be copied from the origination software and pasted into MS Word template document. Photographic images should be inserted in the main body of the article and of high quality. Please follow Figure 1 in preparing pictures. If a figure is from a particular source, you must mention the source. Title of a figure must be put below the figure. Do not put border on the figures.

### Discussion

#### Sub-theme 1; Conceptual finding

The section need to address connections between findings and basic concepts or hypothesis made earlier. Authors should also express whether any arguments were needed relating to other works from other researchers. Write implications made by the work related to theoretical or applications. This section should not be a repetition of the result section. Describe only new and important aspects of the study.

#### Sub-theme 2: Research implication

This session discusses the theoretical implications in the scientific development of psychology and describes practical implications including good practice recommendations that need to be created from research findings or policy implications that need to be responded to by relevant parties as part of a commitment to creating a better life in certain work areas.

## Conclusions

The conclusion should be linked to the title and objectives of the study. Do not make statements not adequately supported by your findings. Present limitations of the study. And give the suggestion for the next research. Write the issues that are new or unsolved, and give the suggestion for the future research, policy suggestions, etc. Do not make further discussions, repeat the abstract, nor only list the results of research results. Do not use bulleted points, use paragraphed sentences instead.

This template is prepared so that all articles published in JIPS : Journal of Indonesian Psychological Science will have a consistent format. Authors must follow this template.

## References

JIPS : Journal of Indonesian Psychological Science prefers articles which refer **mainly to journal articles, research reports, and conference proceedings**, rather than rely heavily on textbooks or handbooks to demonstrate articles' novelty in the subject discussed, up to the last 10 years. Authors are strongly urged to use a reference manager such as **Mendeley** as a tool in referencing is preferable and encouraged. References should be carefully checked for completeness, accuracy, and consistency. References must be prepared according to the APA Style 7<sup>th</sup> Edition as the following examples:

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
