INDIVIDUAL ATHLETE LIMITATIONS: Maximum of 4 events per athlete as per WIAA rule.

AWARDS

FIELD EVENTS

- *Triple Jump:* Girls' first, Boys to follow. Four Jumps. No Finals. Athletes may piggy back first and third. Amount of time for open pit will be determined at coaches meeting. We may combine genders depending on how many entries we have.
- **Long Jump:** Boys first, girls to follow. Four Jumps. No Finals. Athletes may piggy back first and third. Amount of time for open pit will be determined at coaches meeting. We may combine genders depending on how many entries we have.
- *Throws:* 4 throws, no finals. 10 minute warm-up between flights. Boys discus 1st, girls shot 1st. 15 minute warm-up between events.
- *High Jump:* 5 alive format will be followed. Starting height will be the 8th seed minus two heights. Girls first followed by boys.
- *Pole Vault:* Boys 1st, 8th seed minus 2 heights, Girls to follow

GENERAL INFORMATION

TRACK: <u>1/4"</u> spikes (maximum) allowed. Please use chalk (some will be provided). No tape on the track.

TEAM AREAS: All team areas and team tents should be set up outside the fence/stadium
