We want each door to represent one of the 29 French Speaking Countries in the World. To help you pick the country, please use the following <u>sign up genius</u>.

Once you sign up, we'll send home a 'door decorating kit', consisting of a piece of butcher paper pre-cut to the size of the door, construction paper, and a glue stick with your child(ren). From there, feel free to use your creativity and add additional items - just ensure it is connected to the Country you selected. Bonus points if it connects to the 2025 Francophonie theme of "Peace and collaboration". Pro Tip: www.pinterest.com can provide great inspiration! Simply search for : "name of your country" door decorations". If you need something printed, please email the file(s) to lcfrontoffice@theglobeacademy.net. We'll then send the printed item(s) back home to you. Be sure to include your oldest LC child's name in the email.

Ensure all decorations are actually *attached* to the butcher paper. Then roll up the butcher paper (with the decorations facing inside), secure it with a few rubber bands, labeled with your child's Name, Grade and Homeroom, then send it back to school with your child. Staff will then hang it up on the internal doors. **Door decorations should be sent back to school no later than Monday, Mar 17, 2025**
