

Conifer High School Painting of Senior Parking Spots Class of 2025

Event: Senior Painting Party on Saturday, September 6th, 8:00-5:00 (this is the only approved time to paint a spot). It takes approximately 2-3 hours for a detailed design. To participate you must first complete the security form for a parking spot and pay the required fee to the school.

Eligibility:

- Must pay for a '25 - '26 parking pass by Friday, August 29th at noon.
- Must have the design submitted and approved by Friday, August 29th at noon.
- Only the first 150 students with approved designs, signed contracts, and paid fees will be eligible.
- Cost to paint is \$40. All funds raised support CHS Student Media.
- **PAYMENT:** Once your design is approved, Ms. Hislop will add the \$40 fee to your campus account. You cannot paint until the fee is paid.

Senior Parking Spot Contract and Design Submission

Design Guidelines:

- Treat your space like a school-appropriate t-shirt: classy and within the dress code.
- **Prohibited:** gang symbols, drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene content, handicap symbols, political, racial, or slanderous content. Any representations that would cause confusion or promote illegal activities will not be allowed/approved. No offensive/negative/rude language, pictures or symbols are allowed. This includes political and/or racial imagery or text. If you're unsure, please check with an administrator. No tagging or symbolism related to gangs, No double entendres are allowed (these are words or phrases open to two interpretations, one of which is usually risqué or indecent).
- **Permitted:** name, jersey number, hobbies, quotes, slogans, unique personal elements and artistic flair
- **Submission Deadline:** August 29th, Midnight
- Only the first 150 students with approved designs and contracts can paint.
- Must have a regular parking permit to participate.

On the day of the painting party, participating students should park their car in the dirt lot. Check in at the table near the senior lot where we will confirm that your submitted design has been approved by administration, your paint follows paint requirements, you have paid the parking pass and painting fee, and your student contract has been turned in.



- A Senior Parking Design form must be submitted and approved by **August 29th at midnight**
- Be sure your design meets Conifer High School standards!
- The parking spots are limited to a first come, first served basis. The first 150 students to submit their approved design will be able to paint a parking spot. The spots will be randomly assigned.

Paint Requirements:

- **Type:** Only WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint allowed.
- **Border:** Leave a 3-inch unpainted border using blue painters' tape.
- **Purchase:** Available at home supply stores (Home Depot, Lowe's, Walmart, Benjamin Moore).
- **To keep paint costs down, ask for mismatches or other paint that they are trying to get rid of!** Paint stores have lots of opportunities for you to save \$
- **Some spots were painted last year.** You can plan to incorporate those colors into your new design, or you can share a gallon of black paint with friends – thinned with water – to cover the first design. The paint will dry very quickly and you can apply your design.

Unapproved Paints: No oil-based, reflective, spray, fluorescent paints, paint sprayers, or clear coat.

What to Bring:

- Paint, brushes, rollers, paint pans, tape. Long handles for rollers will save your back!
- Broom, sunscreen, drinks, stencils, rags, trash bags, speaker, drop cloth, paint clothes, water, and snacks.

Cleanup:

- Take all paint supplies with you; nothing can be disposed of at Conifer.
- Ensure designs are school-appropriate; inappropriate designs will be painted over in black.
- Clean up any mess you make.

SUGGESTED SUPPLY LIST and PRO TIPS:

- Approved, Water-Based Exterior Latex Paint in the necessary colors
 - Consider working with peers to choose colors. Paint can be expensive (\$20-30/gallon), but if several people share the same colors, they pay less overall, and have more colors to choose from.
- Paint brushes, paint rollers, painter's tape/stencils, paint trays
- Water bucket and water for dirty brushes and paper towels
- Chalk to sketch out design first
- Towels/blankets/lawn chairs to sit on; maybe a pop-up tent for shade
- Hats and/or sunscreen; pop-up tent, clothes for painting; water for drinking, it may be hot
- Trash bags for cleanup
- Remember, all painting must be completed on the painting day. Students may not repaint or touch up their spots throughout the year; we expect them to naturally wash off over the course of the year.
- If for some reason the space needs to be repainted because of graffiti or vandalism, the student must speak with Security.

Please design your Senior parking space in the template below. Please make sure the design is in full color and will truly represent what it will look like in real-life (scale, colors, etc.). Make sure you are following all guidelines and rules with regards to content.

IMPORTANT:

Please note that reserving and painting parking spaces is a privilege rather than a right. Students who abuse the system or fail to comply with any and all regulations set forth by the school regarding parking or painted parking spots may have this privilege revoked without refund.
