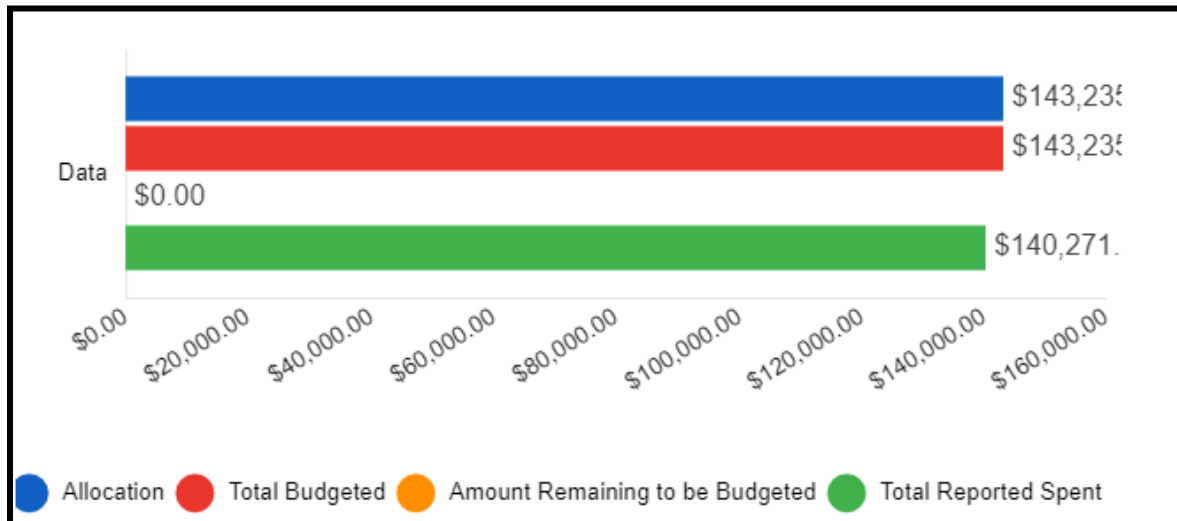


2021-2022 Student Investment Account (SIA) Annual Report

Greetings Crane Union High School Board Members:

Last year, we were allocated \$143,235 in our Student Investment Account (SIA). The SIA is one of the results of the corporate income tax from back in 2018. We budgeted the entire amount, with the lion's share going to the construction of the Paxton Patterson building and CTE supplies. \$10,000 from the SIA was also used to contract with Harney District 4 to hire a part time counselor to provide mental health and behavior supports for our students and families.
