

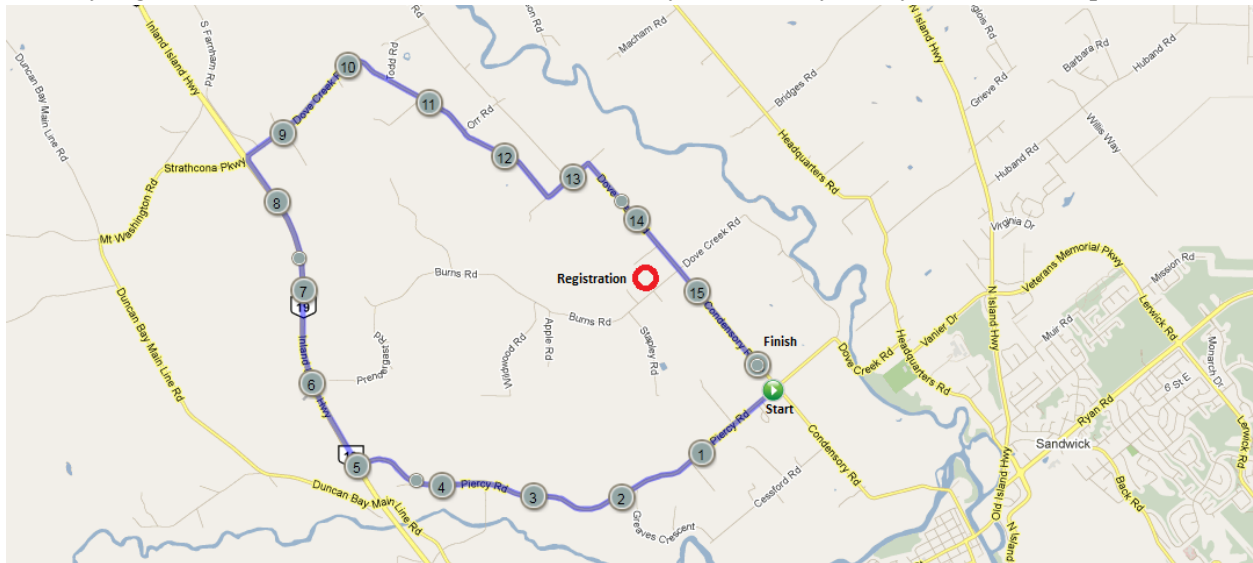
2011 Dove Creek Omnium Race Bible July 16/17, 2011

The 2011 Dove Creek Omnium is comprised of 3 events: a Saturday morning 16.5km time trial, a half hill climb of Mt. Washington on Saturday afternoon, and the Dove Creek road race Sunday morning.

Cost: Adults: \$15 per event or \$40 for all three
Juniors: \$10 per event or \$20 for all three
Master: \$10 TT, \$10 HC, \$20 RR or \$40 for all three

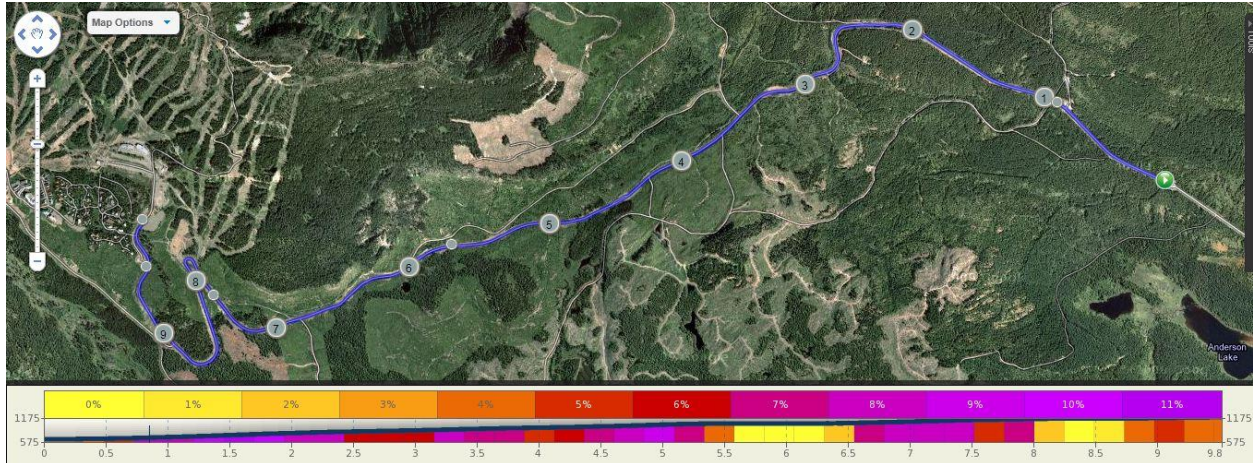
Saturday Morning Time Trial

Registration for the time trial is at the Dove Creek Hall on Burns Road. Registration opens at 10am with the first rider off at 11:01am. There are bathrooms in the Dove Creek Hall, please respect the surrounding areas residents! Time trial bikes are allowed. Riders will start with Novice category, C, B, A in the order that they registered. Riders start and finish near the Piercy-Condensory 4-way. Please see map below!



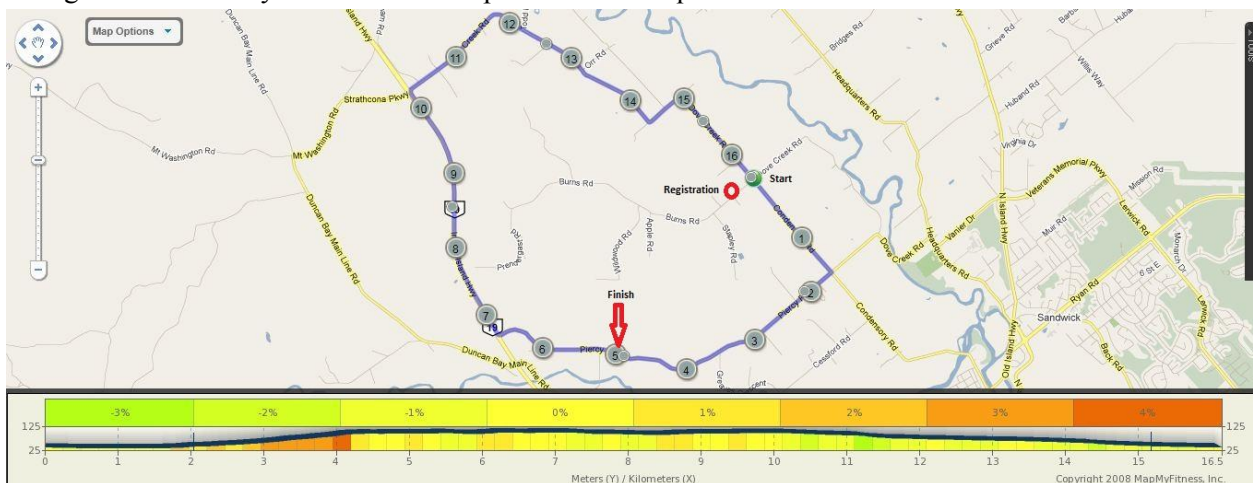
Saturday Afternoon Hill Climb

Registration is at the start line, half way up the mountain, and opens at 1:30pm with all riders off at 2:00pm. Riders will need to find their own way up and down the mountain, transportation will not be provided! There are no bathrooms at the start line, only at the finish line in the main alpine lodge.



Sunday Morning Road Race

Registration is at the Dove Creek Hall on Burns Road, registration opens at 8:00am, with all racers required to attend the pre-race briefing at 8:50am, and all racers will start at 9:00am! There are bathrooms at the Dove Creek Hall, please respect the surrounding resident's property! The course starts at the Burns Rd-Condensory Rd intersection, with the finish line 3km up Piercy Rd (from the Piercy Rd-Condensory rd 4-way). The yellow line rule is always in affect, before, during, and after the race. Any racer found to have gone around the yellow line in the sprint will be disqualified.



Race Lengths: A: 85.34km (5 laps), B: 68.84km (4 laps), C: 35.84km (3 laps), Novice: 19.34km (1 lap)

Notes!

- The yellow line rule is in affect at all times!
- No littering, offenders will be disqualified!
- Bathrooms are provided at two of the three events, no public urination!
- All courses are on open road!
- Results for Saturday will be posted Saturday evening after the TT and HC, results will be posted as soon as possible after the road race, please do not pester the race officials!
- Draw prizes will be awarded following the road race!
- There are no feed zones for the three events
- Points are awarded for all three events, with the winner having accumulated the most points in

their category!

- Dropped riders are allowed to ride with the next group, but must not affect their race in any way!
- If an accident occurs during the race, the race is immediately neutralized, and the group must stop until the injured are taking care of, offenders to this rule will be disqualified!

Local

Local level riders can choose whichever category based on their race experience/fitness. If a club member is over the age of 30, they can choose whether to race masters or not! CVCC club members in the running for the Comox Cup series are competing against each other for all three events, points for the series will only be awarded for the CVCC members!

Masters

Master level riders will be split with all master level riders over age 55 racing in the B category, and all master level riders under the age of 55 riding in the A category. All three events are masters sanctioned!

Directions:

From the New Island Highway for the TT and RR: Take 1st right onto Piercy Road (5.1km), take left on Condensory (1.6km), take a left onto Burns Road (160m), take a right into the Dove Creek Hall parking lot.

From the New Island Highway for the HC: Take left onto the Strathcona Parkway (8.4km), park in the chain up area on the widened portion of the road.
