The manuscript was written using **Palatino Linotype**, A4 paper, font size 12, spacing 1.15, normal margins (*top 2.5 cm", left 2.5 cm", bottom 2 cm", right 2 cm"*) consisting of 4,000-6,000 words, and references used at least 35 (80% in the form of journals published in the last 10 years). Citations was written using Mendeley or Zotero in the style of **the 7th American Psychological Association (APA)**.
