

Coding Decomposition: “I want my hat back” by Jon Klassen

Scene 1:

- Bear: moves to talk to pig
 - Have pig hop in place to acknowledge that he is living
 - Bear asks question
 - Needs an envelope to send so the rabbit responds
 - Rabbit responds
 - Same colored envelope attached
 - Bear moves to frog
 - Frog is hopping the whole time

Scene 2:

- Bear talks to frog
 - Frog hops twice but not the whole time because it is distracting
 - Use a loop to get there
 - Bear asks frog a question
 - Use envelope code
 - Frog answers the question
 - Uses the same colored envelope to respond
 - Bear moves on to rabbit
 - Frog hops to the side so bear and rabbit can be seen

Scene 3:

- Bear talks to rabbit
 - Sees the hat, stops what he is saying
 - Uses colored envelope to have this dialog
 - Rabbit shuffles away slightly
 - Two move to the side blocks
 - Frog runs away
 - Face into the background would be funny?

Scene 4:

- Bear talks to other animals
 - They ask him a question
 - Use the colored envelope

- Bear answers
 - With same colored envelope
- Bat is animated
 - Flaps its wings
 - Hops twice in the air
