The registry - implementation

There is already a lightweight implementation of a registry which is in use. This version is based on a Google Sheet as holder of the information, and a light web interface to this sheet. A more scalable platform is wanted and needed.

Maintenance

The registry must be maintained over its lifetime, which will be a continuous responsibility for the Registry Working Group. Workflows for submitting entries must be established, so community members know how to add new items or make updates.

The work done by the group's members will be voluntary or paid by the respective institutions, and there is no need for extra funding.
