

Spring 2024 LSUS Dual Enrollment- Deadline to Apply- January 12, 2024

Courses Available (teacher, high school course name and college course name)

***White- Human Anatomy-** BIOS 284 **AND** BIOS 284L (4 credits): Human Anatomy and Physiology/Lab

White- Medical Terminology- KHS201: Medical Terminology (3 credits) **(this course is not eligible for free tuition)**

***Algood- Precalculus-** MATH 150: Precalculus (3 credits)

***Algood- Statistics-** MATH 210: Applied Statistics (3 credits)

***Algood- Calculus-** MATH 221: Analytic Geometry and Calculus I (3 credits)

***Jefferson-Physics I Honors-** PHYS 251 **AND** 251L: General Physics/General Physics Lab (4 credits)

***Jefferson- Physics AP-** PHYS 261 **AND** 261L: General Physics for Science Majors/Lab work for Science Majors (4 credits)

***Carberry- English IV AP-** *ENGL 115: Composition II, *ENGL 205: Survey British Lit (3 credits)

Minimum Criteria for Enrollment

1. Students must be on track for completing the TOPS University Curriculum
2. Students must have an A or B in the first semester course for which they plan to apply
3. Student must have a 2.5 cumulative gpa on a 4.0 scale
4. ACT composite score of at least 19 *and* ACT English score of at least 18 *and* ACT Math score of 19; for all science courses the ACT math subscore must be at least 21*

See Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy if you do not meet the testing criteria, but would still like to enroll in dual enrollment courses.

Payment- students are allowed one free dual enrollment class at each university during the second semester (Medical Terminology courses is not eligible for free tuition) Funds are limited and will be distributed on a first come-first served basis.

Tuition- English, Medical Terminology, Advanced Math, Pre-Calculus, and Statistics are \$150/course

AP Biology, Human Anatomy, Calculus, Physics Honors, and AP Physics courses are \$200/course because they earn an additional lab credit.

Payment will be made directly to LSUS. Payments will be available in the student's account **January 22**. Students will be dropped if payment is not made by **January 25**.

Returning DE Students: (Students who enrolled in a DE course Fall 2023)

- 1) Complete the docusign at the following link:

- 4) Submit the docusign page to your counseling in the Counseling Office.

New DE Students:

Step 1

- 1) Go to <https://apply.lsus.edu/>
- 2) Click "Start Application"
- 3) Choose "Dual Enrollment Application"
- 4) Follow the steps to complete and submit the application. Select Spring 2024 for the application term.

If you took dual enrollment courses at LSUS during the 2022-2023 school year (junior year) you must complete the application using the e-mail address used the previous year. Contact Jennie Bynog with any questions- 318-797-5058 or jennie.bynog@lsus.edu. Do NOT WAIT until the last day to do this.

Step 2- submit the dual enrollment registration/course selection via Docusign. This link will be sent to you after you submit the LSUS application (15 minute delay) If you do not receive the link, contact Jennie Bynog jennie.bynog@lsus.edu; (318)797-5058)

Reminder- if you are taking a course that also has a lab,(all science courses and AP Calculus) you and your parent must sign both courses on the course selection document. All forms must be signed electronically. You cannot print and sign manually.
