

Role Description: Field Team Regional Leaders

Arranged into 9 regions, Field Team Regional Leaders provide organization and support to the field members in their geographical region. As such, they are involved, but not limited to, the following tasks in support of the states and alliances:

- Linking state coordinators and alliance co-chairs with each other to provide mentorship, sharing, and collaboration on projects and products - especially the formation of new Alliances
- Advising and collaborating, on behalf of their regions, in planning and development activities at the national level
- If possible, attending the monthly Field Team meeting/calls (first Monday of the month)
- Convening and conducting regional meetings, as per the wishes of their members.
- Dealing with concerns before they become issues
- Advocating for the States and Alliances in their region to the larger Field Team
- Function as an Advisor to the Co-Directors
- Ensure that their existing role (state coordinator or alliance co-chair) is sufficiently covered. if needed.

Requirements:

- Served at least 6 months as a State Coordinator or served at least 6 months as an Alliance Co-Chair
- 2. One state coordinator/one Alliance chair representing red/blue for each region
- 3. Attend Monday night Field calls on a regular basis

Benefits

- Grow personal impact on the strategic direction of the field and the mission of Braver Angels
- 2. Develop a closer relationship with Senior Leadership in Braver Angels
- 3. Participate in the first leadership development cohort provided by the Field Team

Desired Outcomes

1. Formation of a deep 'civic friendship' between leaders, coordinators and co-chairs within and between field units and national.
