QUESTIONS:

1. Please explain why and how a car insurance claim can be denied by an insurer. What are some common things that carriers deny? What are some common reasons behind this?
2. What is a claim denial letter? When is it sent/when does it arrive? What is included/indicated in a typical claim denial letter? Why do you receive a letter vs. an email or phone call?
3. How can you appeal a car insurance claim denial? Please provide detailed tips, including tips on why, when, and how to:
 1. Gather important documents – which documents?
 2. Review your car insurance policy – for what
 3. Contact your insurance company – which way is best: phone, email, or letter? When contacting, what should you ask about or request? What should your tone/approach be?
 4. Document your steps/progress (keep records)
 5. Submit an appeal letter: Please provide step-by-step instructions on how to craft an effective appeal letter, what should be included versus not included, and when and where to send it.
 6. Consider hiring a lawyer or public adjuster: explain when and why it might be beneficial to do so, the costs involved, the likely outcome, and if/when you recommend this step or not.
4. What should you do if your car insurance appeal efforts are denied? What further recourse/options do you have, including:
 1. Mediation – how does this work?
 2. Arbitration – how does this work?
 3. Filing a lawsuit – how does this work?
5. How do you best recommend appealing a car insurance claim denial? What is your best advice here, and what would you personally do in this situation?
