Chapters

V. Week Two

The Hero Licensing Exam comes upon them, whether Izuku's ready or not. Thankfully for them, Amori-sensei has a heart enough to open up his "daycare" for the event, watching over the little terrors only for that day. The week really kicks off after they retrieve their babies, although Izuku has some more breathing room since the infant is passed onto Todoroki for the week.

Unfortunately for Todoroki, he has to juggle his extra practicals along with everything else now. What a time to have the infant.
