Grant Requests		 Kye Mohagen - \$700 - Reading Intervention - district offers SIPS, but hoping for REWARDS reading program, kids for 3rd, 4th, 5th, and reading intervention. REWARDS is tier 2.5 intervention. It is a pilot grogram to see if it works, and could be an example for the district. If SIPS and rewards don't work, helps to identify learning disabilities Anna motion to approve, Caroline 2nd, Majority in favor yay Kye Mohagen - \$4000 - 5th grade storage Basically all teachers in modular classrooms do not have any storage like teachers in the building. Kyle was tasked with doing the request for the 5th grade teachers. Spot will be in the quad for the shed, there is a drain, back right up to the ramp by McKenchie'sc classroom, walked with facilities, 			

- easy snow removal, etc. Ideally they wanted it installed before it snows.
- There was talk about going to Home Depot and ordering but Kyle doesn't have the \$4k to go do that
 - Darcy mentioned most of all that, including an accurate quote, can be completed online, no need to go to Home Depot!
- Katie K. mentioned we should approve up to a certain amount today so they can get started on the ordering process
- Rachael Kuttel mentioned the district called around about the bond for GES improvements, general public disagreed on adding another tax, so it wasn't added as a special measure so now GES is just waiting for improvements. Adding the shed is showing them how we are dealing with our current setup
- Katie motion to approve the request up to \$5000, Caroline 2nd, the yays have it.
- Music Grants approved by Board: Steve Kershiznik, stage curtain lights
- Suzie Bates Dale Crazy Creek chairs She has purchased crazy creek chairs for outdoor science lessons. She would like to purchase a class set for teachers to use as well, not just science. She already has 10 but needs more for the class set and would like to be reimbursed. (total. \$1,081.15) Rachel P has a connection at the company, might be cheaper, Susie will chat with Rachel P. The idea is all classes, not just science, can take their lessons outdoors
 - motion to approve Anna, Rachel P second. Yays have it.

 - At this time, she is requesting the \$167 her mom already spent for the mural (receipt uploaded already)

 - Requesting funds for rolling cart, 5
