Tech Ethics
- Audience: All Staff - Please access this course in Better & Better. Suicide Awareness & Prevention Training
- Nebraska State Law (Neb. Rev. Stat.§ 79-2, 145-146) provides for annual education about suicide awareness and prevention. The target audience identified by the Nebraska Department of Education is any staff member having contact with students.
