Dear Parents,

To complement our work around the water cycle and rivers, we are planning a day visit to the area around Malham in the Yorkshire Dales.

Children in **5KH will visit on Wednesday, 3rd July**, and children in **5HB will visit on Friday, 5th July**.

We will be travelling by school minibuses, and to get the most out of the visit, we are going to extend the school day. We would like children in school at **8:30 am**, and we will aim to return by **5:00 pm**.

Because we are using the school minibuses, there is no charge for this trip. However, if your child would like an ice cream at the end of the walk, please **pay £2 on ParentPay before Monday, 1st July**. Unfortunately, we will be unable to buy an ice cream for those children whose parents do not pay the £2.

Your child will require a hearty packed lunch for the day, and you may like to include a couple of extra snacks. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch, please indicate this on the reply slip.

Conditions in July can still be very wet; therefore, it is important that your child has a good waterproof coat if any rain is forecast. Even if it is dry, your child is likely to get rather wet 'playing' in the water below Gordale Scar. Your child will be walking approximately 5 miles, sometimes over difficult ground, and will require a set of walking boots or other sturdy footwear. Sturdy trainers with good grips, 'approach shoes,' or even wellies will be suitable. Please indicate if you would like to borrow some school wellies. Please ensure that your child is wearing thick socks or more than one pair of thinner socks – wellies or shoes should feel firm around the foot and ankle. **Canvas pumps, Ugg boots, or other 'fashion shoes' are not appropriate.**

Given that we will be splashing about at Gordale, we would recommend supplying a spare 'bottom half' of clothes, including underwear and a small towel, to carry in a rucksack (or bag with comfortable, padded straps). Children will also need a carrier bag to put their wet clothes in afterward. Your child might like to pack the jelly/swim shoes that they took on the residential.

It should be a good trip whatever the weather: if it's sunny, that is great, and if it is rainy, then the waterfalls look more spectacular and it feels like more of an adventure!
