**You have to swap your answer sheets and take it in turns to guess why your partner has written the words or phrases in the squares. You do this by asking and answering past**

**Example:**

Student A has written the word **'bag'** in one of the squares.

Student B: Did you bring a bag to class today?

Student A: No, I didn't.

Student B: Did you buy a bag yesterday?

Student A: Yes, I did. I bought a new sports bag.

Once the word or phrase has been guessed correctly, it can be crossed off.
