Congrats to our teams for a historic season so far! We wanted to remind our spectators of a few guidelines that need to be addressed ahead of a great experience for our team, coaches, and school.

**CCS Sportsmanship Policy:** A person who can take a loss or defeat without complaint or victory without gloating, and who treats his/her opponents with fairness, courtesy and respect.

The following behavior is unacceptable at all CIF/CCS/BVAL high school contests:

- A. Berating an opponent's school or mascot;
- B. Berating opposing players;
- C. Obscene cheers or gestures;
- D. Negative signs;
- E. Artificial noise-makers;
- F. Complaining about officials' calls (either verbally or by gestures);
- G. Actions by a school and/or team that are intended to embarrass or humiliate their opponent and/or show a lack of respect for their opponent or the integrity of the sport.
- H. "Body-painting" that either would or would not necessitate the removal, or partial removal, of what a reasonable person would consider to be normal clothing

**Prohibited:** We also want to remind you of what is not allowed, some are section and our league bylaw rules:

- Smoke bombs, tailgating, tents, outside food/coolers, bikes/scooters/skateboards, non-service animals
- Anyone under the influence or participates in any other illegal activity, will be referred to the San Jose Police Department, who will be on site before, during, or after the contest.
- Anything that takes away from the student, player, and fan experience.

**Tickets:** Buy through [www.GoFan.co](http://www.GoFan.co) Gates open one hour before kickoff.

- Tickets sold through the 3rd quarter, all spectators must enter before the start of the 4th quarter (pre purchased tickets ONLY)
- No Ins/Outs (no re-entry once ticket is redeemed)
- Bags to be checked upon entry, however, no student backpacks are permitted.

**Field Authorization:** Each team will manage it's own sidelines (must have current CCS lanyard)

- Only players, coaches, officials, press (with media credentials), and school personnel allowed on the field (with a current CCS lanyard)
- All others, please enjoy the game from the stands. You may join the players on the field after they are dismissed by their coaches.

This is a great opportunity to show our CCS & CIF communities how our fans create and leave a positive impression at our events. Please remember to cheer positively (towards our team, other team, coaches, officials) Thanks for your support all year long for our team's amazing season, regardless of the outcome of the contest. Just a reminder that if it is a Championship Game, a ceremony will take place afterwards and all spectators are expected to stay in the stands, win or lose, celebrating both teams for their hard efforts immediately following the game. **Go SAINTS!**
