Privacy Policy

Developer (referred to as "we," "us," or "our") operates the Toy Merge: Playtime Drop mobile application (hereinafter the "Service"). This document provides information about our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service, as well as the options you have in relation to this data.

We collect and utilize your data to provide and enhance the Service. By using the Service, you acknowledge that your information may be gathered and utilized according to this policy. Definitions

Service

The Toy Merge: Playtime Drop mobile application operated by Developer.

Personal Data

Any details about a living individual that can be used to identify that person (either from those details alone or from those details combined with other information likely in our possession).

Usage Data

Data automatically collected when using the Service or generated by the Service's infrastructure (for instance, how long a user stays on a particular page).

Cookies

Small files stored on your computer or mobile device.

Information Collection and Use

We gather several types of information for various purposes to deliver and improve our Service.

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While you use our Service, we may request certain personally identifiable details that could be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data"). Examples include, but are not limited to:

Cookies and Usage Data

Usage Data

When you access the Service from a mobile device, we may automatically collect specific details, such as the type of mobile device you use, its unique ID, its IP address, its operating system, the type of mobile internet browser, unique device identifiers, and diagnostic data ("Usage Data").

Tracking & Cookies Data

We utilize cookies and similar tracking technologies to observe activity within our Service and hold certain information.

- Session Cookies. Used to run the Service during each session.
- Preference Cookies. Used to remember user settings and various preferences.
- Security Cookies. Used to maintain security.

Use of Data

We use the data collected for various purposes, including to:

- 1. Operate and maintain the Service
- 2. Notify you about changes to the Service
- 3. Allow you to participate in interactive features should you choose to do so
- 4. Provide user support and customer service
- 5. Gather analysis or valuable information to help improve the Service
- 6. Monitor usage of the Service

We take all reasonably necessary steps to ensure your data is handled securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We do not transfer your Personal Data to an organization or country without confirming that appropriate data protection measures are in place.

Disclosure of Data

We may disclose your Personal Data if we believe in good faith that doing so is necessary to:

- 1. Comply with a legal obligation
- 2. Protect and defend our rights or property
- 3. Investigate or prevent possible wrongdoing associated with the Service
- 4. Safeguard the personal safety of Service users or the public
- 5. Defend against legal liability
