CALSA Focus on Results 2027 Registration Terms and Conditions

Terms and Conditions (“TOS”) of Attendance and Participation at the California Association of Latino Superintendents and Administrators (“CALSA”) **2027 Focus on Results Summit**

These are the terms and conditions (the “Agreement”) that govern your attendance at and/or participation in the CALSA 2026 Focus on Results Summit (the “Event”).

By registering for the Event you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.. If you are registering on behalf of another participant it is your responsibility to ensure that the person attending is aware of these terms and accepts them, and by completing the registration you are warranting that you have made the attendee aware of these terms and that they have accepted these terms.

1. Event Admission

1.1. Admittance. Your registration entitles you to admittance to the Event. Any and all other costs associated with your attendance (including without limitation any travel and/or accommodation expenses) shall be borne solely by you and CALSA shall have no liability for such costs.

1.2. It is your responsibility to inform us at info@calsa.org of any special access requirements or dietary requirements at the time of registration, and in any event no later than three weeks in advance of the Event. Any dietary requests made less than three weeks in advance before an Event may not be available.

1.3. You acknowledge that CALSA reserves the right to refuse entry by any participant to the Event or remove of any participant from the Event without any liability and at its sole discretion. CALSA reserves the right to recover from you any loss or damage incurred or suffered by us, the Event Venue or any other participants as a result of your conduct at the Event or failure to comply with these Terms. In such circumstances, a participant shall not be entitled to a refund of any fees.

1.4. Media. By attending the Event you acknowledge and agree to grant CALSA the right at the Event to record, film, photograph or capture your likeness in any media now available and hereafter developed and to distribute, broadcast, use or otherwise globally to disseminate, in perpetuity, such media without any further approval from you or any payment to you. This grant to CALSA includes, but is not limited to, the right to edit such media, the right to use the media alone or together with other information, and the right to allow others to use and/or disseminate the media.

1.5. Event Content. You acknowledge and agree that CALSA, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to change any and all aspects of the Event, including but not limited to, the Event name, themes, content, program, speakers, performers, hosts, moderators, and time.

2. Fee(s)

2.1. **Payment.** The payment of the applicable fee(s) for the Event is due upon registration. If such payment is insufficient or declined for any reason CALSA may refuse to admit you to the Event and shall have no liability in that regard.

2.2. **Taxes.** The fee(s) may be subject to sales tax, value added tax, or any other taxes and duties which, if applicable, will be charged to you in addition to the fee(s).

3. Substitution and Cancellation Policy

3.1 Registrations are **non-refundable**. However, your registration may be transferred to another individual or applied toward a future CALSA event.

6.3. The maximum aggregate liability of CALSA for any claim in any way connected with therewith or this Agreement whether in contract, tort or otherwise (including any negligent act or omission) shall be limited to the amount paid by you to CALSA under this Agreement to attend the Event.
