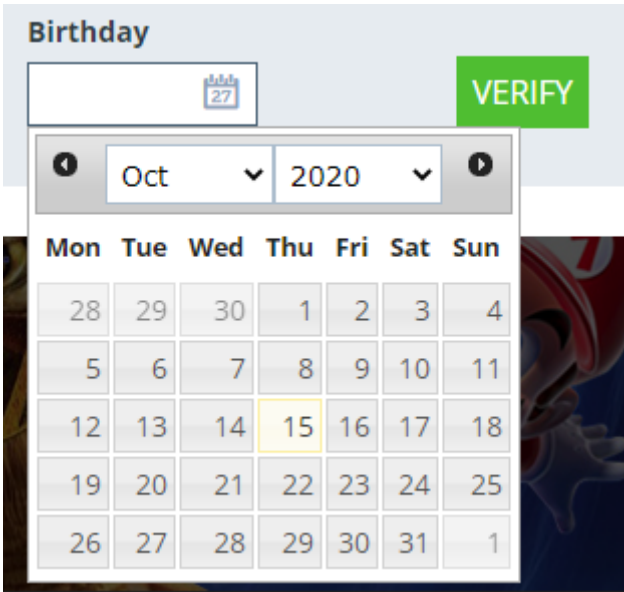
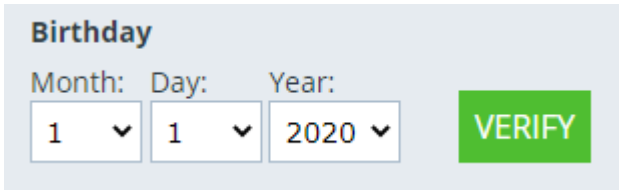

4. Adding and Configuring Notifications

Navigate to **Marketing > Popup notifications** menu. Here you are able to add and configure notifications. All added notifications can be sorted by priority, name, popup content and status.

Priority	Name	Popup content	Status

- **Priority** - notifications at objects they are added to will be displayed according to set priority.
- **Name** - notification title in the general list.
- **Popup content** - content type.
- **Status** - *enabled* or *disabled*.

To add a new notification, click “+” in the top right corner of the screen.

4.2 Content

This tab is used to configure notification **content**.

- SMARTY editor (**SMARTY content** is filled in the corresponding field)
- Product (**select product** by clicking "+")
- Page (**select page** by clicking "+")
- Blog (**add blog post** by clicking "+")
- Newsletters: subscription form (select **mailing list** where user(s) will be added after subscription and **button text**)
- Terms and Conditions (set **Redirect URL** (users will be redirected to that URL if they don't accept terms and conditions) and **notice text for "Accept" button**)
- Age verification (set **age limit** and **Redirect URL** (users will be redirected to that URL if they don't pass age verification))

4.2.1 Content Configuration

- *Image* (select a file).
- *Background color of the contentegular popup* (is selected from picker)
- *Show popup header* (Notification name is used as the header)
- *User-defined CSS-class* (is used for custom visual style)

4.3.1 Popup Display Settings

Position - page space to display notification at:

- *Top left*
- *Top center*
- *Top right*
- *Center left*
- *Center*
- *Center right*
- *Bottom left*
- *Bottom center*
- *Bottom right*

Margin and **padding** - set in pixels.

Auto size - notification resolution will be automatically resized to match its content. If this setting is disabled, you may set **width** and **height** manually.

4.3.2 Popup Effects Settings

Popup effect - list of animated effects.

Animation speed:

- *Slower*
- *Slow*
- *Normal*
- *Fast*
- *Faster*

4.3.3 Popup Show Settings

Delay to show popup (seconds) - set to 0 to show notifications right after the page is loaded.

Show after scrolling the page (px) - number of pixels to scroll down for notification to pop-up. Set to 0 to ignore the setting.

Re-show after (hours) - set to 0 to display every time the page is visited.

Show once in a session - notification will be shown to the user only once per session.

Close popup automatically in (seconds) - set to 0 to ignore the setting.

Block main content - content on the background will be blocked by the pop-up notification, scrolling will also be unavailable.

Show on leaving the page - notification will be displayed when closing the browser tab.

Stop all other popups (highest priority) - only selected notification will be displayed at object.

4.4.1 Where to Show Popup

Click **“add condition”** to select object(s) for displaying notification at:

4.4.2 To Whom Show

Click “**add users**” to select users for displaying notification to.

User groups - notification will be shown to users from selected groups.

Show for countries - display notification according to user's geolocation.

4.4.3 Period of Availability

Use available period - set time period, when current notification will be displayed. If this setting is active, you need to specify **available from** and **available till** dates.

Once the notification settings are configured, click **create** in the top right corner of the screen.

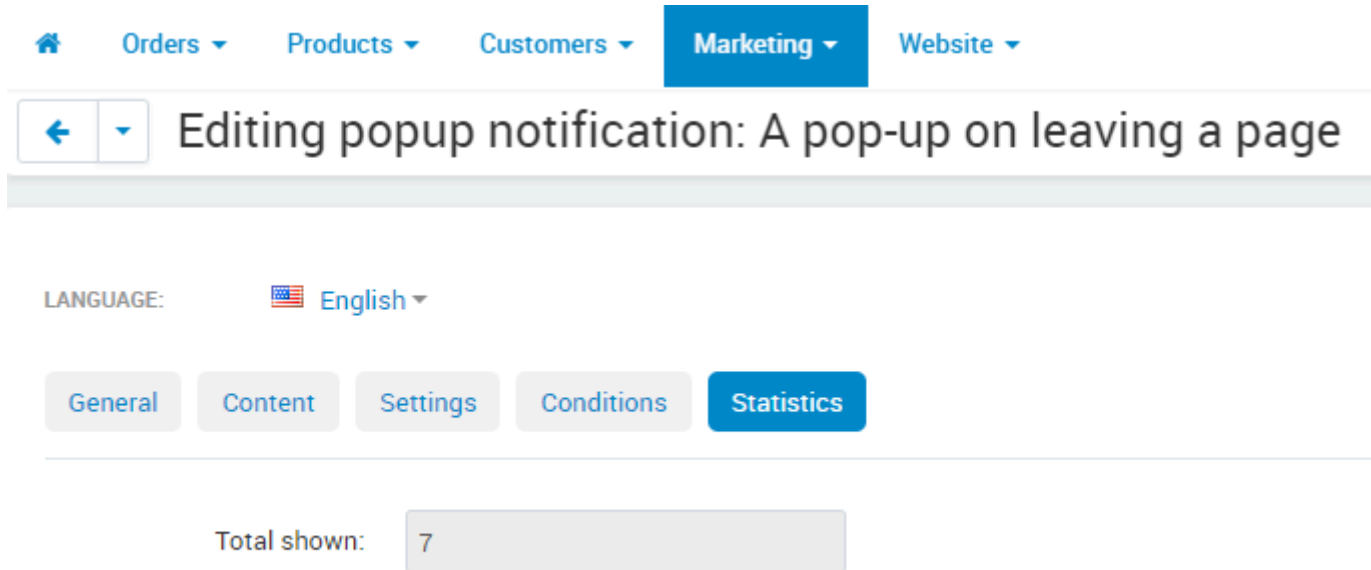

5. Statistics

Once the pop-up notification is created, the **Statistics** tab will appear:

6. Display Pop-up Notification on Click

To display pop-up notification on clicking a certain element at the storefront, navigate to existing notifications settings. Detailed manual is found at the top right corner of the screen when clicking **view/hide instructions of manual pop-up call**:

1. Go to **Marketing > Popup notifications** in the administration panel of your store.
2. Click + (plus) button to create a new notification or select an existing one.
3. Configure the notification and update it if necessary.
4. Find the "User defined class to use for manual popup call" item and copy the value in bold.
5. Use this value in the *User-defined CSS-class* for the menu element you need to open the popup, or in the "class" attribute of any link or other html element.
6. Here is an example for menu element:
 - Go to **Design > Menus > [menu_name] > [menu_item]**
 - Find the **User-defined CSS-class** field and paste the text you copied in item 4
