Technology access for students:

Chromebooks and hotspots are available for all students to borrow and take home. A donation has recently made 25 desktops available for students to own at home. Volunteers and staff are supporting setup of desktops.		
Chromebooks are available to students in our digital literacy workplace class during their class. They also have access to Microsoft Office applications during class through the MORE account.		
Chromebooks are also available for students during an open lab time each week. A volunteer proctor helps with navigation at this time.
