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Our mission: “Providing Peer Support to Children and Adults Grieving a Loss Due to a Difficult Life Event”.

Rainbow Kids offers peer support for children (age 4 and up) and adults that are dealing with loss such as the death of a loved one, divorce, separation, incarceration, or abandonment.

Children meet weekly for nine weeks in groups of around 5-7 kids with a trained facilitator. Each week a different topic is discussed pertaining to loss and most weeks will also have an activity to go along with the topic.

Rainbow Kids helps kids learn to **communicate** with other kids that are dealing with similar situations and understand that **they are not alone**.

Our adult sessions are held at the same time as the kids’ groups. Adults do not need to have kids to register for sessions. **Everyone is welcome**.

Grieving is the natural process of healing from an emotional loss. If grief is left unresolved, it can affect one’s physical and emotional health, school or job performance, and the ability to develop healthy, lasting relationships.
