

****Cases Requiring Booking at MSCH**

Maternal Conditions

- Pregestational diabetes on insulin
- Significant cardiac disease (e.g. aortic stenosis, mitral stenosis, dilated aortic root)
- Patients requiring cardiac or invasive intrapartum monitoring (e.g. SVT, pulmonary HT)
- Poorly controlled seizure disorder (e.g. seizure in the current pregnancy)
- Sickle cell anemia
- Patients requiring therapeutic anticoagulation during labor
- HIV positive
- BMI>45
- Obstructive sleep apnea
- Jehovah's Witnesses
- Chronic opioid use

Fetal Conditions

- Higher-order multiple gestations
- Any twins
- Major structural anomalies (e.g. CNS anomalies, CHD, CDH, abdominal wall defects, LUTO)
- Cases requiring EXIT procedure
- Suspected or documented fetal anemia / NAIT / hydrops
- IUGR with absent or reversed end-diastolic flow in the umbilical artery

Obstetric Conditions

- Suspected abnormal placental adherence (e.g. accreta, increta, percreta)
- Placenta previa

- Quaternary cesareans and above or otherwise complicated surgical history
- Urgent/emergent cerclage placement

**If there are patients who do not fall into the above categories but the provider thinks should be delivered at MSCH, please contact the Allen Chief of OB and/or MSCH Labor and Delivery Medical Director or designee to discuss.
