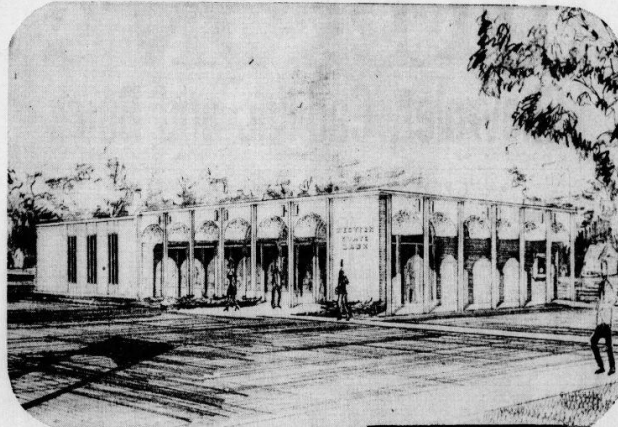

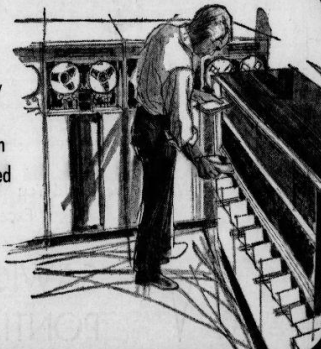

## Lloyd E. Hanneman

Lloyd E. Hanneman, age 73, of Oshkosh, passed away on Friday, April 12, 1996 at home with his family. He was born August 8, 1922 in Oshkosh, a son of Conrad and Justine (Ruhl) Hanneman. Evelyn F. Lautenschlager and he were joined in marriage on May 6, 1943 at Zion Lutheran Church.

Lloyd was a 1940 graduate of Oshkosh High School and began working at the Farmers State Bank in Larsen in 1944. He then served in the U.S. Army during World War II in the European Theater, serving with the 101st Airborne Division in the Signal Company. He attained the rank of First Sergeant and participated in the September 1944 Holland Invasion and Battle of the Bulge at Belgium in December 1944. He was discharged in December 1945.

Lloyd continued his banking career in Larsen for 24½ years. He graduated from the School of Banking in 1957 and was elected president of his class. Lloyd came to Oshkosh in 1965 and founded the Western State Bank on Sawyer Street, which later became M&I Western State Bank. He served as President and Chairman of the Board until his retirement in 1987. Lloyd continued to serve on the Board of Directors of M&I

and currently was a member of the Community Advisory Board of Associated Bank of Oshkosh.

Lloyd was a member of Zion Lutheran Church. As a younger man he belonged to the DeMoleay and for 25 years the Winneconne Masonic Lodge.

He had a life membership with the 101st Airborne.

Surviving are his wife of nearly 53 years, Evelyn of Oshkosh; daughter and son-in-law, Mary Hanneman and John Marx of Madison; son and daughter-in-law, Dr. Michael Hanneman and Dr.

Karen Dustrude of Oshkosh and grandchildren, Sarah and Peter Hanneman. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Miles Hanneman.

Services will be Sunday (today) at 3:00 p.m. in Zion Lutheran Church, the Reverend Clyde Friedman officiating. Burial will be at Lake View Memorial Park. Military honors will be provided by the VFW.

Family and friends may call at the church today from 12:30 p.m. until the service. Memorials are appreciated to the American Cancer Society and to Zion Lutheran Church.
